PHOTO COMPOSITION BASICS



RULE OF THIRDS

The subject of the photo is off center. As if a tic-tac-toe board was placed over the frame, the subject should align with one of the four points where the lines intersect.



BIRD'S EYE VIEW

The photo is taken from a high to low angle. The photographer or camera is above the action. Photographer might stand on a chair or ladder to achieve this effect.



WORM'S EYE VIEW

The photo is taken from a low to high angle. The photographer or camera is below the action/subject. Photographer might kneel or lie on the ground to achieve this effect.
